**Q1** The state legislature is currently debating a bill that would designate the Palisade peach as the state fruit of Colorado. Would you say you support or oppose this measure?

*Support* ..... 49%  
*Oppose* ..... 17%  
*Not sure* ..... 34%

**Q2** The state legislature is currently debating a bill that helps ensure Amtrak will continue to provide passenger train service to southeast Colorado, including Pueblo, but may end up costing the state up to \$4 million annually. Would you say you support or oppose this measure?

*Support* ..... 42%  
*Oppose* ..... 37%  
*Not sure* ..... 21%

**Q3** The state legislature is currently debating a bill that makes it harder for parents to exempt their children from being immunized if they attend Colorado public schools. Instead of the current 'opt-out' provision, if passed, parents would be required to show proof that they received additional information about the benefits and risks of immunization before being allowed to exempt their children. Would you say you support or oppose this measure?

**Q4** The state legislature is currently debating a bill that would cost \$4 million a year, for a total of \$12 million over three years, to provide enhanced unemployment insurance compensation benefits for eligible individuals enrolled in approved job training programs and entering into new occupations. Would you say you support or oppose this measure?

*Oppose* ..... 33%  
*Not sure* ..... 16%

**Q5** For 100 years, oil companies assumed they had the power of eminent domain to take private property for purposes of installing oil pipelines; however, the Colorado Supreme Court recently said that was incorrect. In response, the state legislature is currently debating a bill that would grant oil companies the ability to take private property through eminent domain when they cannot come to an agreement with the property owners in order to install their oil pipelines. Would you say you support or oppose this measure?
